RULES

- 1. All Federal, State, local parks and wildlife regulations shall apply at all times.
- 2. Any public boat ramp south of Felsenthal, North of the Columbia locks and any of the river tributaries in between may be used. ONLY NAVIGATABLE WATERWAYS CAN BE FISHED. CONTESTANTS CAN NOT LEAVE THEIR BOAT TO GAIN ACCESS TO ANY WATERS. INCLUDES WALKING TO OR PULLING BOAT INTO SAID WATERS.
- 3. First cast will be at **6:00am** on May 20th.
- 4. Each person in the boat must be a paid contestant of this tournament and abide by all tournament rules and regulations.
- 5. All bass caught by contestants fishing together will be disqualified if any of the contestants are found to be in violation of any tournament rules and regulations.
- 6. Tournament officials have the right, at their sole discretion, to refuse ANY entry.
- 7. Participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or adult with written parental permission at registration.
- 8. CONTESTANTS: Doubles Tournament Pick your own partner. Entry fee non-refundable. No exceptions.
- Trailering bass to the weigh-in site is allowed. You must be in line to weigh your fish by 3:00pm. When the clock strikes
 pm the line for weigh in will be closed!!!
- 10. Only five (5) bass allowed in possession in tournament boat at any one time. You must cull your catch after the fifth fish.
- 11. SCORING: Scoring will be based on the weight of largemouth bass with a minimum length of 12 inches. Only five (5) fish per boat will be counted. Fish presented for weighing that are less than 12 inches in length will be disqualified and one pound will be deducted from the days allowable weight as a penalty. If more than, five (5) fish are presented for weight then the largest fish will be disqualified.
- 12. For each legal dead bass presented to tournament director for weigh in, the team shall be penalized .25 (or 4oz.) per dead fish.

Fishing Times

There will be no blast off. Fishing time will begin at **6:00am** on May 20th. Any public boat ramp south of Felsenthal, North of Columbia locks and any of the navigable river tributaries in between may be used. You must be in line to weigh your fish by **3:00pm**.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

- 1. Entry fee must be paid before fishing.
- 2. No refund or substitution of entry fee for any reason will be given.
- 3. All teams <u>MUST</u> check in with the tournament officials <u>BEFORE FISHING</u>. Check in is the same as late registration times listed below.
- 4. The entry fee for the tournament is \$150. All early registered personnel will be eligible for a prize drawing the day of the tournament at weigh-in. Early registration will take place until Friday May 12th at Toledo Tackle, Honey Hole, Twin City Tint, Camouflage Shop and online at taylorfisher.org. Your entry fee may also be mailed in to the address provided.
- 5. Late Registration will be held at the Lazarre Park on Thursday May 18th, Saturday May 20th. Registration will begin at 3pm and end at 8pm on May 18th & 19th. - 1. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are expected from every participant.
- 2. All bass weighed in will become the property of the tournament and will be released back into the tournament waters from which they were caught, live if possible.
- 3. For conservation reasons, all bass brought to official weigh-in station must be in a weigh-in bag with water.
- 4. No contestant may win more than one place per official tournament.
- 5. Minimal length of bass to be weighed is 12 inches.
- Weigh in will be conducted from noon until
 3:00pm, May 20th, 2023 at LAZARRE. Fish must be in line by 3:00pm to weigh.
- 7. In case of ties, order in which fish are weighed will determine standings.
- 8. Any contestant(s) may be subject to a polygraph.
